The PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART agree that no part of the cost of operation shall fall on the Municipality and they also agree that each of their organizations shall contribute a fair share to the maintenance and upkeep of the building situated on the said lots and the members of each organization shall have the right to use the building mentioned above at mutually agreeable times.
