A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No.501 enacts as follows:-

- The Council is hereby authorized whenever it deems it to be necessary or expedient to enter upon land adjoining any road allowence or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting fences as a measure to provent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during the winter months.
- 2. The person or persons authorized by council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right of entry on private property for such purpose only.
- Any person who refuses the right of entry or who in any way hinders entry upon land for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this bylaw shall be deemed to be guilty of an offense and liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of The Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, this 4th day of February A.D. 1954, at Paradise Hill, in the Province of Saskatchewan.
