## BYLAW No. 9

A BYLAW to provide for the extermination of Gophers.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501, enacts as follows:-

- l. Every owner or occupant of land within the municipality shall on or before the 15th day of May in each year take proper steps to exterminate gophers on his land.
- If any such owner or occupant neglects or refuses to comply with the provisions of section 1, the council may have the said work done under the supervision of the councillor of the division in which such neglect or refusal occurs and the muncipality may recover the amount expended in the work performed in the manner as municipal taxes, provided that the amount so expended shall not exceed two and one half cents per acre.
- Any such amount which has not been satisfied on or before the thirty-first day of December next following its expenditure shall be added to and form part of the levy for municipal purposes of such lands in all respects as if it were an original tax; and it shall have the same effect on the land and may be recovered in any of the modes for recovery of such taxes, and the amount so recovered shall form part of the general revenue of the municipality.
