BYLAW No. 10

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Frenchman Butte No. 501 enacts as follows:

- 1. The council may purchase chemicals or chemical preparations for the destruction of noxious weeds, and may sell the same to the owners or occupants of land within the municipality.
- Any owner or occupant of land within the municipality may upon request obtain from the secretary-treasurer such quanity of chemicals or chemical preparations as shall be deemed reasonably sufficient for the destruction of noxious weeds on his land, at a price equivalent to the cost price of such chemicals or chemical preparations to the municipality.
- Any owner or occupant of land purchasing chemicals or chemical preparations under the provisions of this Bylaw shall use the same for the destruction of noxious weeds on his lands within the municipality only, and shall be subject to the directions of the weed inspector in the use of such chemicals or chemical preparations.
- 4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
