INFORMATION FOR SUPPLIERS

1. Submission of Tenders

Submissions of tenders for "Tractor" will be received in a sealed envelope clearly marked as **TRACTOR TENDER**, or by email by the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 as follows:

 - Tenders received later than the time specified will not be accepted regardless of the post mark date or courier delivery schedule.
 - **The lowest priced tender or any tender not necessarily accepted.**
- The opening of tenders will take place on **February 4, 2026 at 3:00 p.m.**
- A decision will be made by resolution of Municipal Council on **February 25, 2026**.

2. Tender Documents

3. Tender Information

The R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 wishes to purchase 1 Tractor.

Provincial Sales Tax and G.S.T. applicable shall be entered in separately from unit prices.

4. Right to Accept or Reject Tenders

The tender shall be based upon the whole of the Specifications without reservations. Please list all standard and optional equipment as well as any other pertinent information needed for council to make a fair comparison. Please complete and submit the *Tender Cover Page*.

The Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender other than the lowest tender without stating reasons.

Tenders which are incomplete, conditional, obscure or which do not meet the requirements shall be rejected.

Erasures/alterations must be initialled by the tenderer.

Tenders received later than the time specified will not be accepted regardless of the post mark date or courier delivery schedule.

The Municipality reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders and to waive irregularities and informalities at its discretion

5. Unacceptable or Unbalanced Tenders

Each item in the tender shall be a reasonable price for such item. Under no circumstance will an unbalanced tender be considered. The R.M of Frenchman Butte No. 501 will be the sole judge of such matters, and should any tender be considered unbalanced it will be rejected.

6. Interpretation of Documents

If a prospective tenderer is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of the specifications, documents or find omissions or errors they must notify the Public Works Supervisor – Dan Fedirko @ 639-343-7973. If an addendum or change is deemed necessary, the changes will be posted on the RM website and on SaskTenders.ca.

7. Increase in Quote

No claim for increase in rates on unit prices or other prices will be entertained. Any and all charges not set out in the tender, must be clearly indicated on the agreement of sale.

8. Payments

Payment would be issued at the first meeting of Council (Council meets every 3 weeks) following the delivery of the Tractor to the R.M. yard and upon inspection by the Public Works Supervisor.

9. Execution of Contract

Failure by the successful bidder to meet the above requirements will entitle the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 to cancel the purchase. The R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 may then elect to award the contract to another bidder or take such action as they choose.

10. Presentations

Sales representatives must address all sales presentations and trade in viewing to the Public Works Supervisor prior to tender closing date. The Municipality is asking for your best price and all submitted information and prices at the tender opening is the only price being accepted.

11. Delivery Date

The unit must be delivered to the R.M. of Frenchman Butte No. 501 yard located on Pt. SW-11-53-24-W3 **ASAP**.

- 12V and USB power outlets in cab;
- High-capacity alternator, bidders to state alternator output;
- Pre-wired for two-way radio / GPS (switched power and antenna pass-through);
- electric rear window defroster;
- am/fm radio;
- three rear view mirrors (1 interior and 2 exterior);
- cup holder, floor mat;
- gauges for engine temperature, transmission temperature, articulation and fuel;
